PYP (Prohibited Yard Parking) is now in effect!

The Prohibited Yard Parking ordinance will be enforced for the entire subdivision; Sections: I, IIa, IIb, III, IV, V and VI. This ordinance is a Misdemeanor and the fine is \$150.00 ***per day!***

Stay Alert! If you see something, say something, do something. The easiest thing to do is call the HPD non-emergency number 713-884-3131.

Dues! If you pay your 2025 Dues before April 1st, 2025 they are \$40. However, If you wait until after April 1st the dues will be \$50..

Attention Neighbors!

Please pick up ***your*** signs after ***your*** garage/yard sale. Remember only TWO garage/yard sales per year are allowed. There is a City Ordinance limiting garage/yard sales to two per year. You can be ***fined*** by the City if you hold more than two sales.

Deed Restrictions:

Please contact the Architectural Committee before you build, add on or start any type of construction. There are consequences if you don't follow the deed restrictions. Call Gerry Vander-Lyn at 832-643-9060.

City Ordinances: *Please note that you can be fined if you violate a city ordinance!*

NO LOUD MUSIC and **NO PARKING ON THE LAWN**

NO LOOSE DOGS, they must be on a leash or fenced.

NO 18 wheelers or cabs in the neighborhood (unless loading or unloading).

NO Food trucks/trailers parked or stored in the neighborhood.

NO Work equipment parked on the city streets or in the driveway overnight.

NO Equipo estacionado en las calles de la ciudad o en el camino de entrada durante la noche.

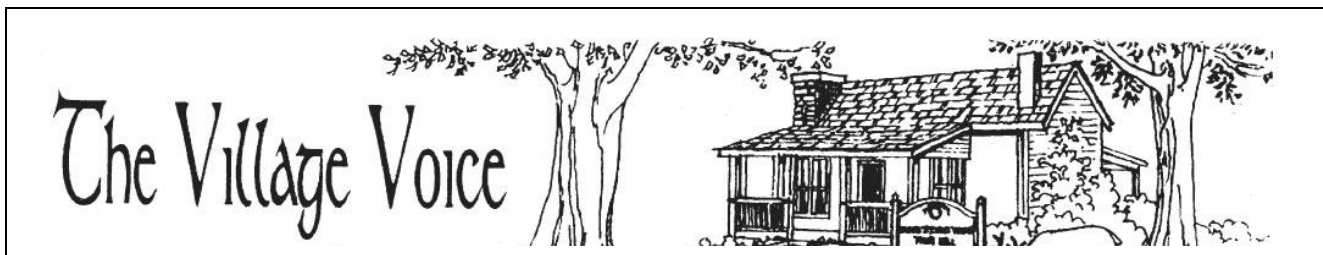
